At the Lincoln Community Center, the health of our members is our number one priority. As much as possible, it will be our intent to continue to offer LCC programs and facilities during the time of the Coronavirus situation. We would also like to provide you with information about our cleaning products and ways you can help reduce the spread of human contact illness at the LCC or elsewhere.

Our local, state, and national leaders are currently monitoring the situation closely and in cooperation with the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, they will continue to provide instructions to businesses and individuals on how to proceed moving forward.

We have confirmed that the products that are being used to clean LCC facilities on a daily basis do kill the Coronavirus and other bacteria and viruses that cause influenza, the common cold, and other human contact illnesses.

Recently, we started providing disinfectant spray in some of adult areas of our facilities. In addition, we are offering hand sanitizer in more areas of our facilities. We will continue to offer these products during the Coronavirus situation as long as they are available from our suppliers.

You can partner with us to reduce the spread of human contact illnesses by adhering to the following common sense practices:

- **COVER:** Cough into the crook of your elbow or into a tissue as opposed to your hand.
- **CLEAN:** Wash/disinfect your hands frequently and wipe down exercise equipment when you have finished using it.
- **CONTAIN:** Stay home and avoid others if you are sick. If you have a condition resulting in a compromised immune system, it may be wise to avoid events with large groups of people such as youth sporting events at the LCC or elsewhere.
